I. Executive Summary

- 1. The Pechanga Band of Luiseño Indians and the Pechanga Resort and Casino employed 1,912 residents of Senate District 36 during 2003.
- 2. The Pechanga Band of Luiseño Indians and the Pechanga Resort and Casino were directly responsible for \$114,464,281 in wages, benefits and other payments to individuals residing in Senate District 36 during 2003.
- 3. The Tribe and the Pechanga Resort and Casino purchased \$19,996,934 worth of goods and services from firms in Senate District 36 during the year.
- 4. The Tribe's direct activities resulted in the payment of \$26,555,713 in state and federal payroll and income taxes from residents of Senate District 36.
- 5. In addition to the direct effects of the Tribe's activities, these activities also have multiplier effects on the rest of the district's economy. Our estimates indicate that the Tribe's activities were indirectly responsible for the creation of 6,954 jobs that paid wages and benefits totaling \$202,727,689 in 2003. In addition, purchases of goods and services in the amount of \$46,528,866 occurred as a result of the Tribe's activities.
