

## San Diego County

A portion of Assembly District 66 lies within San Diego County. The Tribe and the Pechanga Resort and Casino directly employed 106 San Diego County residents. The Tribe paid \$4,236,984 in wages, benefits and distributions to residents in 2003. The Tribe's activities indirectly contributed to the creation of 231 jobs paying \$7,504,123 in wages and benefits in San Diego County. The Tribe's activities resulted in direct purchases of \$327,383 and indirect purchases of \$761,756 of goods and services from San Diego County suppliers located in District 66.
