Hemet

The Tribe and the Pechanga Resort and Casino employed 218 Hemet residents in 2003. Individuals residing in the district received payments totaling \$12,040,857 from tribal activities. The Tribe and Casino were responsible for direct purchases of \$1,694,052 from Hemet merchants and suppliers in the district. The Tribe's activities were responsible for the indirect creation of 705 jobs and the purchase of \$3,941,720 worth of goods and services in Assembly District 65.

The combined direct and indirect effects of the Tribe and Pechanga Resort and Casino's activities accounted for the creation of 923 jobs paying \$33,366,561 in wages and benefits. The Tribe's activities also resulted in \$5,635,772 in purchases of goods and services from Hemet suppliers in the district.
